
Fabric Requirements and Cutting Guide

	Yardage	Brown	Teal/Green	Description
Fabric A	1-3/4 yards	9544-0113	9544-0150	large floral border
Fabric B	1-1/2 yards	9545-0140	9545-0114	allover flowers
Fabric C	1 yard	9546-0113	9546-0150	stripe
Fabric D	1 yard	9547-0113	9547-0154	scattered leaves
Fabric E	3/4 yard	9547-0140	9547-0142	scattered leaves
Fabric F	2/3 yard	9548-0113	9548-0154	random dots
Fabric G	1 yard	9548-0133	9548-0156	random dots
Fabric H	1 yard	9549-0113	9549-0154	paisley
Backing	6 yards	9546-0113	9546-0150	stripe

Cutting

- Fabric A** Cut (8) 6-1/2" x wof strips, sew in sets of two strips using (2) strips for the outside borders. Trim the (2) top/bottom borders to 6-1/2" x 77-1/2". Trim the (2) side borders to 6-1/2" x 84-1/2"
- Fabric B** Cut (13) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut the strips into (75) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
- Fabric C** Cut (8) 3-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end matching stripes at joining, then cut (2) side borders 3-1/2" x 84" and (2) top/bottom borders 3-1/2" x 65"
- Fabric D** Cut (3) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut these strips into (25) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
Cut (8) 2-1/4" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end for binding; trim remainder of 3rd strip after cutting rectangles from 3-1/2" to 2-1/4" for additional binding
- Fabric E** Cut (3) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (25) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (8) 1-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end to end for middle borders, then cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 82-1/2" side borders and (2) 1-1/2" x 65-1/2" top/bottom borders
- Fabric F** Cut (5) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (25) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
- Fabric G** Cut (9) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (50) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
- Fabric H** Cut (9) 3-1/2" x wof strips, recut into (50) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
- Backing** Cut backing into (2) equal pieces and sew together selvedge-to-selvedge for backing




Instructions

Note: This quilt is constructed in horizontal rows. Refer to the quilt assembly diagram to sew the alternating rows 1 and rows 2.

- Row 1** –Begin with (1) square E, then joining together the short ends of the rectangles add (3) rectangles B, (1) rectangle D, (1) rectangle F, (2) rectangles G, and (2) rectangles G to make the row. Make 13 rows.
 - Row 2** - Begin with rectangles add (3) rectangles B, (1) rectangle D, (1) rectangle F, (2) rectangles G, and (2) rectangles G, ending with (1) square E to make the row. Make 12 rows.
- Sew the rows together, alternating rows 1 and rows 2 to make the center section of the quilt top. There are 25 rows in the center section of the quilt top.
- Stripe borders:** Center and sew a fabric C side border to opposite sides of the quilt top allowing equal amounts of excess fabric to extend beyond the quilt center on each end. Stop stitching 1/4" from the end of the quilt center. Join the top/bottom fabric C borders in the same manner. Miter the corners and trim away excess fabric. Press seams out towards the outside edges of the quilt top.
- Middle borders:** Join a 1-1/2" x 82-1/2" fabric E border to opposite sides of the quilt top. Join the 1-1/2" x 65-1/2" fabric E borders to the top/bottom of the quilt top.
- Outside borders:** Join the 6-1/2" x 84-1/2" fabric A borders to opposite sides of the quilt top. Join the 1-1/2" x 77-1/2" fabric A borders to the top/bottom of the quilt top to complete the quilt top.

Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt the layers together. Bind to finish the outside edges.
