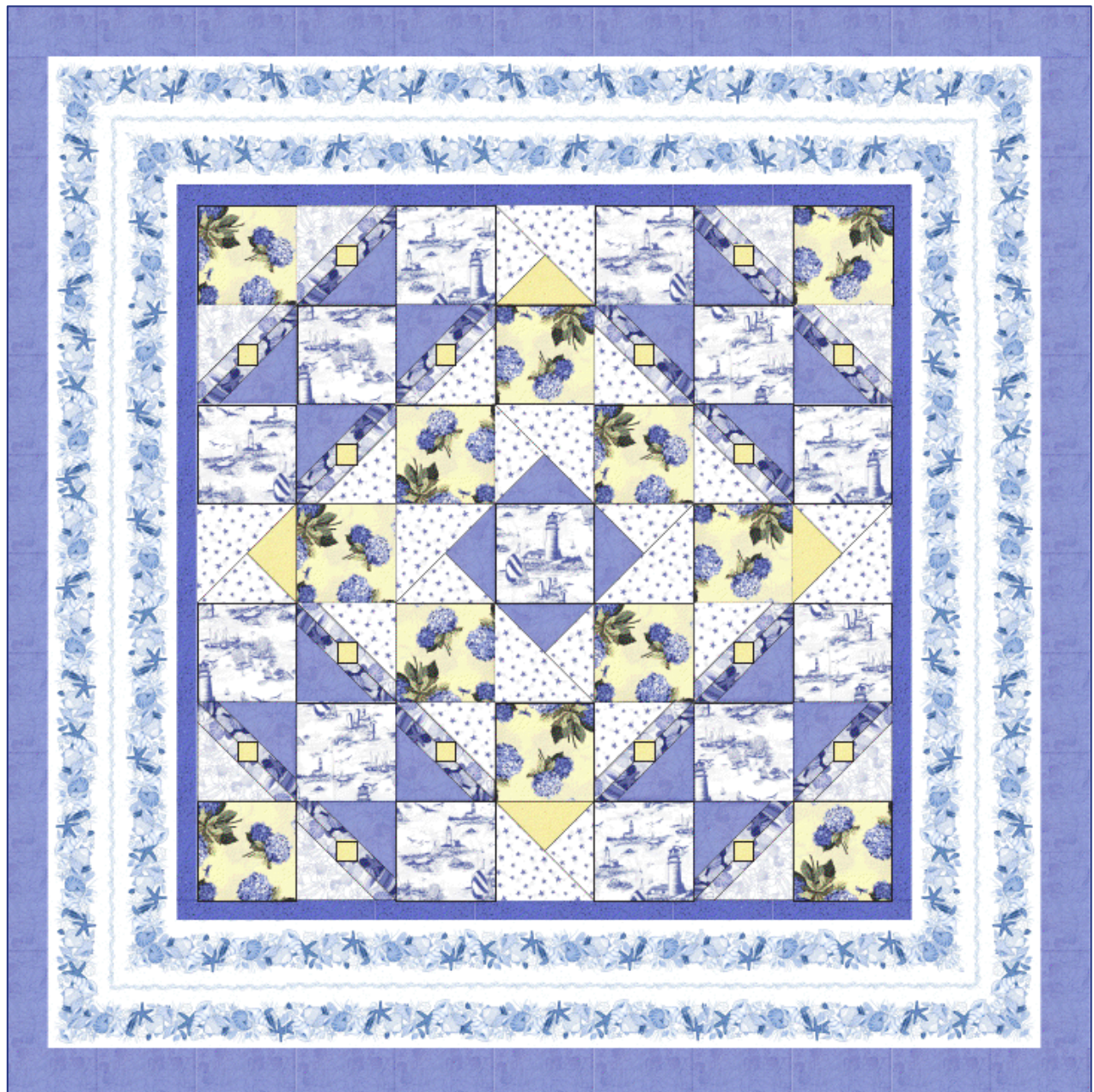

Block Size: 8", Layout: 7 blocks x 7 blocks

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- A: 7/8 yd hydrangea on yellow 2973-0133
 B: 1½ yd toile 2974-0150
 C: ¼ yd blue toile shell on white 2979-0150
 D: 7/8 yd starfish 2976-0199
 3rd border and E: 1¾ yd blue tonal shell 2979-0199
 F: 3/8 yd blue shells on dark blue background 2975-0150
 G: 3/8 yd blue shells on white background 2975-0199
 H: ½ yd yellow pebble 2977-0142
 1st border I: ¾ yd blue pebble 2977-0150
 2nd border and binding J: 6 yd border stripe 2972-0150
 Backing: 9 yards

CUTTING GUIDE

- From A cut (3) 8½" strips then (12) 8½" x 8½"
- From B cut (13) 8½" x 8½" "fussy cut" squares (pick your favorite scenes)
- From C cut (1) 6 7/8" strip then (4) 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" then cut on the diagonal
- From D cut:
 - (1) 6 7/8" strip then (4) 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" then cut on the diagonal
 - (1) 9¼" strip then (2) 9¼" x 9¼" then cut with an "x"
 - (1) 8 7/8" strip then (4) 8 7/8" x 8 7/8" then cut on the diagonal
- From E cut:
 - (2) 6 7/8" strip then (8) 6 7/8" x 6 7/8" then cut on the diagonal
 - (1) 9¼" strip then (1) 9¼" x 9¼" then cut with an "x"
 - 3rd border: (9) 3½" strips
- From F cut (6) 2" strips then (16) 2" x 13"
- From G cut (6) 2" strips then (16) 2" x 13"
- From H cut:
 - (1) 9¼" strip then (1) 9¼" x 9¼" then cut with an "x"
 - (1) 2½" strip then (16) 2½" x 2½"
- From I cut 1st border: (8) 2½" strips
- From J cut 2nd border: (4) 13½" strips the length of the fabric, using a 3 yard piece (see quilt diagram to view border cut). You will have leftover fabric which you should use for the binding.

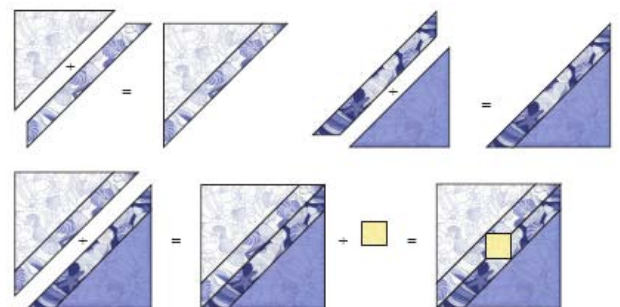


DIAGRAM 1 - Make 8 blocks

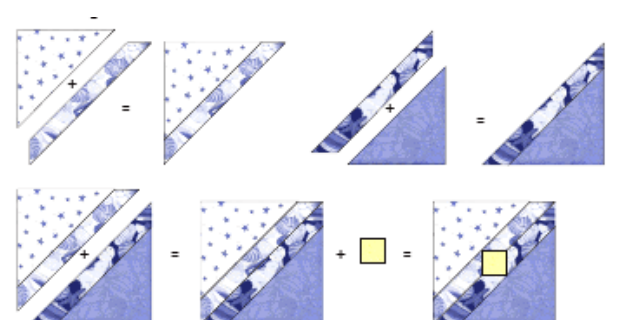


DIAGRAM 2 - Make 8 blocks

INSTRUCTIONS:

(NOTE: Be sure to sew with a scant ¼" seam allowance)

- Follow diagrams 1 and 2: Sew 2" x 13" strip of Fabric F to 6 7/8" triangle of Fabric C. The 2" strip will extend beyond the triangle on both ends. Trim to size of triangle. Make 8 units. Repeat above with 2" x 13" strip of Fabric F to 6 7/8" triangle of Fabric D make 8 units
- Follow diagrams 1 and 2: Sew 2" x 13" strip of Fabric G to 6 7/8" triangle of Fabric E. Trim to size of triangle. Make 16 units.
- Join the block halves together, making 8 with starfish and 8 with shell toile.
- Using 2½" x 2½" Fabric H, iron under ¼" seam allowance around the square and appliqué onto center of block.

5. Follow Diagram 3: Sew Fabric D triangle to Fabric H triangle.
Make 4 units.
Sew Fabric D triangle to Fabric E triangle. Make 4 units.
Add Fabric D 8 7/8" triangle to each unit, making a total of 8 blocks
6. Join blocks in rows, using 7 x 7 layout as shown in Diagram 4
7. Borders: Add 1st border.
8. Add 2nd border, mitering the corners.
9. Add 3rd border.
10. Layer, quilt and bind!

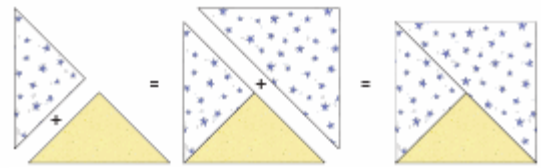


DIAGRAM 3 - Make 4 Yellow

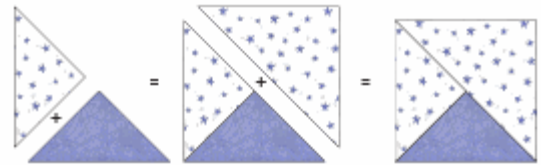


DIAGRAM 3 - Make 4 Blue
